Arrival at Queen Alia International Airport, meet with our Representative & driver then your vehicle will drive you to your hotel in Madba for the overnight.

Day 2: Madaba - Nebo - Bathany - Dead Sea - Madaba









Breakfast at the hotel in Madba, then drive to visiting Mt. Nebo where Moses has gone to get a view of the Promised Land before he died & visit the church Then Drive to Bathany (Al-Maghtas) Situated on the eastern bank of the River Jordan, nine kilometers north of the Dead Sea, the site is believed to be the location where Jesus of Nazareth was baptized by John the Baptist. It features Roman and Byzantine remains including churches and chapels, a monastery, caves that have been used by hermits and pools in which baptisms were celebrated, testifying to the religious character of the place. The site is a Christian place of pilgrimage. Transfer to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on Earth located 395 meters below sea level. Float in its unique salt rich waters which make it nature's natural spa. Free time to swim & relax. then Drive to Madaba (Church); "The City of Mosaics" a typical East Bank town: underneath almost every house lies a fine Byzantine mosaic. Many of these mosaics have been excavated and are on display in the town's museum, but it is estimated that many more lie hidden waiting to be discovered. Then Back To the hotel in Madaba for the overnight.

Day 5: Madaba - Allenby Bridge

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Allenby Bridge for the departure
